Director's Note

When Dymphna Cusack was advised, by Miles Franklin, to put her frustration with the Australian education system of the 1930's behind her, by writing Morning Sacrifice, the play became known as Dymphna's revenge on the Department of Education! Here was a teacher who had the temerity not only to take on the Department in a compensation claim; she also had the nerve to win her case!

Despite 20 years of excellent teaching credentials, she was reduced in status to supernummary and, with no examination responsibility; her main tasks were to fill in for absent teachers and to make the tea. Is it any wonder she later felt her years as a teacher were wasted?

Nonetheless, with the benefit of hindsight, audiences and actors can only be grateful for her change in career, as her legacy to us was a body of works, fiction and non-fiction, including such theatrical triumphs as "Come in Spinner", "Caddie" and "Morning Sacrifice".

I would like to particularly thank Coralie Fraser, who spent many hours finding (and making) period props, furniture & set dressing items; Paul Gilbert and Anthony Burns who drove trucks, picked up furniture, etc; Glen Harman for his assistance in turning the poster design into "printer" friendly computer files; the Genesian Theatre Company Play reading Committee for choosing such a wonderful 2003/4 Season and to the numerous friends who supported the Cast and Crew of *Morning Sacrifice*.
